COURSE DESCRIPTION

Visual Arts is a course that introduces art through a multi-media experience. Students will learn and apply the seven basic elements of art (Line, Color, Shape, Form, Texture, Value and Space) and the principles of design to produce creative art projects that reflect their understanding of these concepts.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

2 Dimensional Expressive Forms (Drawing)

CXC Standard: Students should develop observational, interpretive and drawing skills of subjects, which will include natural and man- made objects and drawings from life.

Target Behaviors:

- Student should be able to identify and use a variety of media and drawing techniques.
- Student should be able to draw from observation.
- Student can create aesthetically pleasing compositions based on given subjects.
- Student has a relevant working vocabulary in art and design.

2 Dimensional Expressive Forms (Painting and Mixed Media)

Standard: Students should develop the ability to create artwork based on their own interpretation of a given topic or theme using representational and non-representational approaches.

Target Behaviors

- Students should be able to use color to demonstrate expressive qualities.
- Students should show a variety of color harmonies and contrasts.
- Students should apply the elements and Principles of art and design to produce compositions in a variety of media.
